## **Chapter I Overview**

#### **Objectives**

As the policy guidance document, the Accreditation Guide of the Sixth East Asian Games clearly specifies the important dates, work procedure of the accreditation, categories and validity period of various passes, and the establishment of the accreditation facilities, providing a basic guidance for the organization and management of each NOC participating the Games.

#### Overview of Accreditation

The accreditation involves registration, producing, distribution and validation of Identity and Accreditation Card of the Sixth East Asian Games. The purpose of the accreditation is to confirm the identity of the registered personnel and their functions during the Sixth East Asian Games, and to guarantee their necessary access right to perform their duties.

The readers of this Accreditation Guide include the registered personnel of each NOC and the staff members of the Organizing Committee. Targeted at different groups of participants, the Organizing Committee will produce different versions of Accreditation Guide to standardize and guide the accreditation of different groups of people.

## **Chapter II Various Passes**

#### 2.1 Categories and Access Rights

According to their usages, the passes of the Sixth East Asian Games can be divided into two categories, Identity and Accreditation Card and Auxiliary Passes.

Identity and Accreditation Card of the Sixth East Asian Games is the official pass during the Games time issued to the registered participants by Tianjin Organizing Committee with the authorization of the East Asian Games Federation. The validated Identity and Accreditation Card guarantees the holders access to the prescribed zones during the Games time.

Auxiliary Passes are issued for special and temporary purposes and provide limited access to special zones during specified period of time.

#### 2.2 Auxiliary Passes

To satisfy the needs of various groups of people, Tianjin Organizing Committee has prepared three kinds of auxiliary passes—Guest Pass, Upgrade Pass, and Temporary Pass.

#### Guest Pass

Guess Pass is used by the guests (including the registered and unregistered personnel) to enter the non-competition venues, such as the Headquarters Hotels, VIP Hotels, and the hotels for technical officials, athletes and the media, Main Press Center, and other non-competition venues. Tianjin Organizing Committee shall issue Guest Pass to the invited guests.

#### Upgrade Transferable Pass

Upgrade Transferable Pass, abbreviated as "Upgrade Pass", expands the services and privileges of the card holder. Upgrade Pass is issued only to the registered delegates, and is valid when used in conjunction with the Identity Accreditation Card (main cards) of the delegate.

Each NOC will be given one Upgrade Pass for every 50 athletes in its delegation. NOC delegations with no more than 50 athletes will be issued one Upgrade Pass. There is no limit on the number of times an Upgrade

Pass may be transferred. The holder of an Upgrade Pass has access to all the competition venues except the access to the prime events.

Temporary Pass

Temporary Pass is issued to all the people (including both the registered and unregistered personnel) in need of temporary access to competition and non-competition venues.

Temporary Pass is only issued to the following personnel:

The registered personnel whose Identity and Accreditation Cards grant no access to the venue or special zone of the venue where she/he must enter to perform her/his duties;

The registered personnel whose Identity and Accreditation Cards having access to the venue or special zone of the venue have been lost, stolen, forgotten, or have not been received yet;

Unregistered personnel who need to enter the venue or special zone of the venue for various reasons.

#### 2.3 Validity Period

The validity period of the Identity and Accreditation Card of the Sixth East Asian Games is from September 30 to October 18, 2013.

The validity period of the Auxiliary Passes is subject to the need of special or temporary access.



### **Chapter III Identity and Accreditation Card**

Printed on Identity and Accreditation Card of the Sixth East Asian Games is the important information of the holder, such as name, position, NOC, and the code for the access right.

Identity and Accreditation Cards of the Sixth East Asian Games are divided into different kinds according to the personnel information. (please refer to Attached Form E for details).

The Accreditation Center of Tianjin Organizing Committee is responsible for the identity accreditation work of the Sixth East Asian Games.

Drawing the experience of the previous East Asian Games, the Accreditation Center is committed to provide efficient and convenient registration service to all the participants of the Sixth East Asia Games

#### 3.1 Ways of Accreditation

Paper forms and electronic forms will be used for the accreditation of the Sixth East Asian Games. Tianjin Organizing Committee strongly suggests that each NOC choose electronic forms for accreditation.

#### 3.2 Procedure of Accreditation

No.	Issues
1	Tianjin Organizing Committee releases NOC Accreditation Guide of the Sixth East Asian Games.
2	Tianjin Organizing Committee releases Identity and Accreditation Card Application Form.
3	Each NOC mail or e-mail Identity and Accreditation Card Application Forms to Tianjin Organizing Committee before the deadline.
4	Tianjin Organizing Committee verifies the received Application Forms, and send Accreditation Status Report to each NOC.
5	Tianjin Organizing Committee mails the pre-validate Identity and Accreditation Card to each NOC.
6	The NOCs enter China with the pre-validate Identity and Accreditation Card, validate and use the Cards.

#### 3.2.1 Filling Identity and Accreditation Card Application Form

Tianjin Organizing Committee only accepts the accreditation application submitted by the NOCs and relevant organizations recognized by the East Asian Games Federation. Individual accreditation application will not be accepted.

Please refer to Attached Form E to fill in the accreditation form. First choose the right form according to the position of the applicant, and then fill in the form step by step with the real information of the applicant.

Please use simplified Chinese or Latin capital letters A-Z, and Arabic numbers 0-9, except otherwise specified.

The information filled in the Accreditation Application Form must be consistent with the information on the valid identity card of the applicant, including English family name, given name, Chinese name, sex, date of birth, nationality, and ID card number and validity period.

The entourage should also fill in the name of the inviter and the effective ID card number of the inviter used for accreditation application.

NOC

It must be filled by all the applicants.

The applicants should fill in the full name of NOC or International Federations they belong to.

e.g. Chinese Olympic Committee

**English Family Name** 

It must be filled by all the applicants.

The Chinese applicants should use pinyin (in Latin capital letters).

e.g. ZHANG

English Given Name

It must be filled by all the applicants.

The Chinese applicants should use pinyin (in Latin capital letters).

e.g. SAN

It must be filled by all the applicants.

Please refer to Attached Form G to fill in the full name of the country or region of the applicant followed by corresponding code.

It must be filled by all the applicants.

Please refer to Attached Form G to fill in the full name of the country or region issuing the ID card and corresponding code. The nationality fill by an athlete must be consistent with the country/region he or she competes on behalf of.

Height

Please fill in the height of the applicant.

Weight

Please fill in the weight of the applicant.

Blood Type

Please fill in the blood type of the applicant.

**Identity Card** 

It must be filled by all the applicants.

Types of ID Card

Please mark " $\forall$ " in the box corresponding to the type of ID card of the applicant.

Passport (for foreign applicants)

Identity Card (for mainland Chinese applicants)

Exit-Entry Permit (for applicants from Hong Kong SAR, Macao SAR, and Taiwan)

ID Card Number

The ID card number filled in the form must be consistent with the number of the corresponding ID Card.

The ID card must be valid at least before October 18, 2013.

Scanned ID Card

Please scan the corresponding effective ID card. The Chinese applicants must scan both sides of the ID card.

Note:

The validity date of the ID cards of the mainland Chinese applicants whose ID cards are valid permanently should be uniformly filled as December 31, 2030.

Present Residence

The present residence of the applicants must be filled full and complete. Applicants holding the ID cards of the People's Republic of China should fill in the residence printed on the ID cards.

It must be filled by the athletes participating in the Games.

Please refer to Attached Form F to fill in the sport item and corresponding code.

Photo

It must be provided by all the applicants.

The photos should meet the following requirements:

Recent (within six month) colored front photo; clear enough to identify the appearance; unprocessed, unpolished, undamaged, without any stain.

With white or light blue background which is in sharp contrast to the color of the dress

Without cap, turban, band, or sunglasses, except otherwise specified for religious, medical or other special reasons.

The face of the applicant in the middle of the photo and the eyes above the midline;

File in jpeg format, aspect ratio 3:4, and size between 40 to 100kb.

Note:

If the photo provided by an accreditation applicant fails to meet the above-mentioned requirements and looks quite different from the appearance of the applicant, the applicant may be denied of relevant rights and access during the Games time.

Position

It must be filled by all the applicants.

Please choose the position of the applicant and mark " $\sqrt{}$ " in the corresponding box.

e.g. √ Athlete

(17) Signature, Seal and Date of Signing

The printed Accreditation Application Form of all the applicants must

be signed.

The printed Accreditation Application Form submitted to Tianjin Organization Committee must be signed by the NOC chairperson or Secretary General and bear the seal of the NOC. The Application Form without the signature of NOC chairperson or Secretary General and the NOC seal is deemed to be invalid.

3.2.2 Submitting Accreditation Application Data

The deadline for the application of Identity and Accreditation Card is February 28, 2013. The NOCs and relevant organizations shall finish the accreditation application work for all their members participating in the Games in time.

The NOCs and relevant organizations shall fill in the Identity and Accreditation Application Forms, print two copies of each form and the Complete List of the Accreditation Applicants, both with the signature of the NOC chairperson or Secretary General and the seal of the NOC, and mail them, with a copy of the effective ID card of each participant, to Tianjin Organization Committee before February 28, 2013 (local postmark shall prevail).

Note:

In the event that an Accreditation Application Form has to be mailed after the deadline for some special reasons, the NOC or relevant organization shall first submit an application in writing to Tianjin Organizing Committee for approval.

The Accreditation Application Form and Complete List of the Accreditation Applicants without the signature of the NOC chairperson or Secretary General or the seal of the NOC shall not be accepted by Tianjin Organizing Committee.

#### 3.2.3 Revising Accreditation Application Form

If the Accreditation Application Form need to be revised after submission, the NOC or relevant organization shall fill in a Revision Confirmation Form, print a copy of the form, and fax the copy signed by the NOC chairperson or Secretary Genera and with the NOC seal to Tianjin Organizing Committee. Tianjin Organizing Committee shall confirm and revise relevant information of the form according to the Revision Confirmation Form.

#### 3.2.4 Verifying Accreditation Application Form

After receiving the accreditation application data, Tianjin Organizing Committee will verify and process the information of each applicant. The NOCs and relevant organizations will receive from Tianjin Organizing Committee before May 31, 2013 the Accreditation Status Report, which includes the personal information, position, accreditation number and access right of each applicant.

The NOCs and relevant organizations shall check the information of all the applicants in the Accreditation Status Report with Tianjin Organizing Committee via telephone, fax or e-mail.

3.2.5 Making and Mailing the Pre-validate Identity and Accreditation Card

After the NOCs or relevant organizations and Tianjin Organizing Committee confirm that all the accreditation information is correct, Tianjin Organizing Committee will make the pre-validate Identity and Accreditation Card for the applicants and mail them to each NOC or relevant organization before September 10, 2013.

#### 3.2.6 Validating Identity and Accreditation Card

Activation is the process that turns the pre-validate Identity and Accreditation Card of an accredited person into a validated one. Once activated, the card will guarantee that the holder can enjoy corresponding access and other rights.

The pre-validate Identity and Accreditation Card must be activated by the holder in person or by the delegation coordinator with the effective ID card used in accreditation application. If the Identity and Accreditation Card fails to be activated because of the loss, damage of the card or wrong information, the problem must be solve right at the Accreditation Center as soon as possible.

Scope of Work: validation of Identity and Accreditation Card; handling of relevant issues; making and issuing Identity and Accreditation Card and Auxiliary Pass.

#### 3.4 Handling Special Issues

Accreditation Application after the Deadline

In the event that an accreditation application has to be submitted after the deadline for some special reasons, the NOC or relevant organization shall first submit an application in writing to Tianjin Organizing Committee, and register after the approval of Tianjin Organizing Committee.

Note:

The applicants who submit their Accreditation Application Form after the deadline may not be able to receive their Identity and Accreditation Card before September 10, 2013 as other applicants. They must go to the Accreditation Center to fetch their cards.

Loss and Damage of Identity and Accreditation Card

If an Identity and Accreditation Card is lost or damaged, the holder shall report to the NOC, which will promptly inform Tianjin Organizing Committee in writing. The lost or damaged Identity and Accreditation Card will be revoked from the accreditation information system and will not be able to be activated in any circumstance. If the card holder wants to apply for a new card, he/she should submit a written application with the signature of the NOC chairperson or Secretary General and the seal of the NOC to Tianjin Organizing Committee. After the verification and approval of Tianjin Organizing Committee, the Accreditation Center will issue a new

card to the applicant.

Instant making of Identity and Accreditation Card

If an Identity and Accreditation Card need to be made instantly at the Accreditation Center due to some special reasons, the applicant must submit a written application with the signature of the NOC chairperson or Secretary General and the seal of the NOC to Tianjin Organizing Committee. After the verification and approval of Tianjin Organizing Committee, the Accreditation Center will make and issue the Identity and Accreditation Card to the applicant instantly.

The special reasons are as follows:

The applicant is qualified for accreditation but hasn't received the Identity and Accreditation Card due to some special reasons.

The Identity and Accreditation Card is lost or damaged, or has wrong information on it.

Other reasons that need to make the Identity and Accreditation Card instantly at the Accreditation Center

Note:

The card holder must return the card that is damaged or with wrong information to the Accreditation Center before receiving the new card.

Revoking Identity and Accreditation Card

During the Sixth East Asian Games, the following behaviors may lead to the revocation of Identity and Accreditation Card:

Abusive use of Identity and Accreditation Card or violation of the terms of conditions of the regulations in relation to accreditation;

Deemed by the security department as risk to the security of the Sixth East Asian Games;

Other reasons, such as fraud or misrepresentation in accreditation application.
