5. Eligibility

5.1

The NOCs of participating countries and regions are only representative for their athletes taking part in the 6th East Asian Games Volleyball competition.

5.2

Only competitors who comply with East Asian Games Association (EAGA) Constitutions and Constitutions and Rules of the Olympic Council of Asia (OCA) are entitled to participate.

6. Entries

Entry procedures will be conducted in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Constitutions and Rules of the Olympic Council of Asia (OCA).

6.1 Entry by Number

Deadline: 24:00 , April 30, 2013 (Beijing local time)

6.2 Entry by Name

Deadline: 24:00 , August 31, 2013 (Beijing local time)

The completed Entry by Name Forms with all necessary information including the athlete's full name as shown in passport must be submitted for each athlete by the deadline.. NOCs may make changes or submit additional information regarding Entry by Names Forms on or before the deadline, (i.e. 31st August 2013). No any amendments will be permitted after the deadline.

6.3 Team Composition

Each NOC may enter men's and women's teams in Volleyball competition. Each team is to be composed of 12 players and 5 officials (1 team manager, 1 head coach, 1 assistant coach, 1 trainer, 1 team doctor).

7. General Rules and Regulations

The 6th East Asian Games Volleyball competition shall be conducted in accordance with the Fédération Internationale de Volleyball (FIVB) Rules 2009-2012 or the latest competition rules. In case of changes of rules uncovered by the latest Rules, or any disagreement on interpretation of the Rules, it shall be explained and clarified by the Management Committee Director or Chief referee based on the English version of the competition rules and the Technical Handbook. Any unforeseen incident not addressed by the Rules shall be resolved as follows:

- General Issues: Resolved in accordance with the EAGA Constitution.
- Technical Issues: Resolved in accordance with the spirit of the latest FIVB Rules.

8. Competition rules (Method of Play)

8.1 The competition consists of the preliminary round, semi final and final matches.

- If the number of participating teams is 5 or less, a single round-robin system will be adopted in the preliminary round. There are semi final matches between the first (1st) place and the fourth (4th) place teams and between the second (2nd) place and the third (3rd) place teams. The winners of semi final matches will meet in the Gold Medal match and the losers will meet in the Bronze Medal match. The final standings of the other teams shall be followed by the placing of the preliminary round.

- If the number of participating teams is 6 or more, the teams will be divided into two groups, A and B, by a draw. In the preliminary round, each team will play on a single round-robin system for its group placing. In semi finals, the top two teams in each group will play cross-matches as follows: A1 VS B2 and B1 VS A2. The winners of the semi final matches will meet in the Gold Medal match, and the losers will meet in the Bronze Medal match. For the other teams, the teams of the same placing in each group may compete against each other as follows: A3 VS B3 and A4 VS B4, or the cross-match may be played as follows: A3 VS B4 and A4 VS B3. The winners will compete for the 5th and 6th positions. The losers will compete for the 7th and 8th positions. If there are nine participating teams, the 5th placing team in the group of five teams will rank the 9th place.

8.2 Team Ranking

The team ranking is decided by the points gained in each match. The winner and loser will get 3 points and 0 point respectively in a match with a result being 3:0 or 3:1, and will get 2 points and 1 point respectively in a match with a result being 3:2.

In the case of the same points gained by two or more teams, the standings shall be decided by the following standards:

- 1) The team winning more matches will be ranked higher.
- 2) The team with more Z points (total points gained/total points lost) will be ranked higher.
- 3) In case of equality persisting in 1) and 2), the team with more C-value (total matches won/total matches lost) will be ranked higher.

9. Draw

The 6th East Asian Games Organizing Committee (EAGOC) and Chinese Volleyball Association (CVA) will prepare for the draw under the supervision of the Technical Delegate. After the draw, the date, time and venue for the competition will be announced.

10. Medical Control

10.1 Doping Control

Doping control for all events of the 6th East Asian Games will be conducted according to EAGA Medical Committee instructions and will follow the procedures specified by the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA).

10.2 Points for Attention

When an Athlete is notified to be tested against the Doping Control after the match, he /she must go to the Doping Control Station (DCS) with a registered ID Card. The athlete may not go out of the sight of the escort or urinate before arriving at the DCS. The athlete may have a team member present throughout the entire process (a minor must have one). Those who are notified, but fail or refuse to arrive at the designated DCS may constitute an anti-doping rule violation.

11. Equipment

All equipment shall comply with the FIVB Regulations.

IV. Competition Management

1. Management

The responsibility for the management of the competition will be taken by competition officials appointed by the 6th East Asian Games Organizing Committee(EAGOC) from the Chinese Volleyball Association(CVA) under the guidance of the Technical Delegate appointed by the Asian Volleyball Confederation(AVC).

1.1 Technical Officials

National Technical Officials (NTOs) of the 6th East Asian Games Volleyball competition are assigned by the 6th East Asian Games Organizing Committee in consultation with the Chinese Volleyball Association (CVA). The International Technical Officials (ITOs) are assigned by the Chinese Volleyball Association (CVA) in consultation with the Asian Volleyball Confederation (AVC).

The Asian Volleyball Confederation (AVC) will set up a Management Committee before the commencement of the competition, which consists of the following people:

- President of the Management Committee (appointed by AVC)
- AVC Technical Delegate
- AVC Referee representative
- National Technical Officials (NTOs)

1.2 Referees

Following the common practice of the previous East Asian Games, each team may enter one (1) accompanying referee. If the referees are not enough, the vacancies shall be appointed by the Technical Delegate in consultation with Chinese Volleyball Association (CVA).

1.3 Complaints and Appeals

All the complaints and appeals against unfair judgments of referees shall be presented in writing to the Management Committee of Asian Volleyball Confederation (AVC) by Team Manager or Head Coach within 30 minutes after the match. A fee of \$300 US Dollars (or its equivalent in RMB) shall be paid for each appeal to Management Committee of Asian Volleyball Confederation(AVC).

1.4 Technical Meeting and Referees Meeting

The technical meeting and referees meeting will be held one (1) day before the commencement of the competition. The time and venue will be announced in advance once confirmed.

2. Uniforms

All athletes participating in the Volleyball competition must wear the uniforms that complies with the FIVB rules.

3. Victory Ceremony

3.1 Victory Ceremony

The Victory Ceremony will be held after the finals. All award-ees must wear their NOC's official clothing.

3.2 Order of Awards

First Place: Gold Medal and diploma shall be presented to each member of the team

Second Place: Silver Medal and diploma shall be presented to each member of the team

Third Place: Bronze Medal and diploma shall be presented to each member of the team.

V . Approval of Technical Handbook

The Technical Handbook for the 6th East Asian Games Volleyball Competition was approved by the Council of the East Asian Games Association on October 15th, 2012.

VI. Introduction to Tianjin



1. Overview

Tianjin is one of the four municipalities directly under the jurisdiction of the Chinese Central Government, with a current permanent population of 13.55 million, consisting of 16 districts and counties, and occupying a land area of 11,916.9 square kilometers, and with a coastline of 153 kilometers.

Eight hours ahead of GMT, Tianjin lies in the center of the Bohai Bay on the western coast of the Pacific Ocean, between Latitude 38°34' — 40°15' North and between Longitude 116°43' — 118°04' East. It is situated in the northeast of the North Plain in China, about 120 kilometers away from the country's capital city of Beijing.

A major access to the sea in north China, Tianjin has throughout history been an important channel of river and sea transport. As early as in the mid-19th century, it was opened as a trading port, and constant development over the years has made it an important international port and a hub of finance and commerce. The city is conveniently accessible, with well-built facilities for traffic on land, at sea and in the air. Behind, it has a vast hinterland of over two million square kilometers. Externally, it keeps trade contacts with more than 400 harbors of over 180 countries and regions, with a cargo handling capacity exceeding 450 million tons, which ranks the city at the fourth place in the world, and a standard container handling capacity of 11.58 million, standing at the 11th place in the world. Tianjin Binhai International Airport is the largest air transport hub in north China and a major freight distributing center in northeast Asia.

First built over 600 years ago, Tianjin is renowned for its splendid history and culture, boasting more than 100 “firsts” in the history of modern China. In recognition of its rich legacy of historical and cultural relics and remains, the city is reputed as “an epitome of modern China in the past hundred years”. Tianjin is also acclaimed as “an expo of western-style architectures”, with a total of 710 of its exotic buildings identified to be put under protection and preservation. Yang Liu Qing New Year Pictures, Zhang’s Painted Clay Figurines and Wei’s Kites are some of its folk arts known all over the country. A cradle of talented cross-talkers and opera performers, it is called “a center of Peking Opera” and “the land of northern Chinese folk arts”. It is also the birthplace of the modern drama in China.

Tianjin is among the first cities recognized as the country’s most outstanding tourist destinations. Natural tourism resources abound, including mountains, rivers, lakes, sea, springs, wetland, and so on. Representative natural landscapes and places of historical and cultural interests include the scenic spot in Jixian County, the sea-front, the Drum Tower commercial and business street, the Western-style buildings along Wu Da Dao, the Italian-style street, the ancient culture street, the food street, the Tong Luo Wan tourist area in the heart of the city, to name just a few.

Tianjin is an economic center undergoing booming development. As far as the past five years are concerned, the city witnessed a growth of over 16% in gross output value year-on-year to exceed 1 trillion yuan, which translated into a per capita value of 13,000 US dollars. The Binhai New Area, where the national strategic opening-up and development program is being fully implemented, is fast growing to be a new power in driving the regional economy. Construction of a more livable and eco-friendly city is proceeding fast, with its unique style taking shape, characterized by a grandeur and glamour in its integration of Chinese and Western elements, and a blend of both ancient and modern. In conformity with its positioning by the central authorities, Tianjin is well on the way to becoming an international port city, an economic center in north China and an eco-friendly community.

2. Useful Information

Tianjin is eight hours ahead of GMT. It falls within the same time zone as Beijing, using Beijing local time.

- **Voltage**

The standard voltage for residential use is a single-phase AC of 220V/ 50Hz.

- **Diet**

Since ancient times Tianjin has been a renowned producer of fish, shrimp, crabs, clams and other aquatic and marine products. All these, especially seafood, are to the liking of its people. Among its varied traditional flavors, the Goubuli Steamed Bun with Meat Stuffing, the 18th Street Fried Dough Twists and the Er Duo Yan Er Fried Cakes are reputed as “three unique delicacies of Tianjin” enjoying tremendous popularity throughout the world. Historically an important trading port witnessing ceaseless traveling to and fro between the north and south and frequent exchanges with the outside world, varied styles of cooking –Shandong, Shanxi, Henan, Fujian, Guangdong, Zhejiang, and so on – have come to take root here in Tianjin. Court-style dishes and western delicacies are also among the favorites of the local diners.

- **Banks and Foreign Currency Exchange**

The yuan, also called renminbi (RMB), is the local unit of currency and all banks in Tianjin provide RMB services. Foreign currency can be exchanged at any branch of Bank of China. The rate of exchange of foreign currencies to RMB will depend on the quoted exchange rate given that day. Please note that foreign currency cannot be used to pay for any goods or services in China. Most business in China now accepts international credit cards including MasterCard, Visa, American Express and JCB.

VII. Weather Information



1. Climate

Located to the east coast of the Euro-Asia Continent on the middle latitude, Tianjin belongs to the monsoon region of east Asia is chiefly under the influence of the continental climate. It is characterized by distinct seasons – spring is usually windy and dry with only occasional rainfalls; summer is hot, with most of the rainfalls in the year; autumn is cool with comfortable temperatures; and winter is cold and dry without much snow.

只有符合东亚运动会联合会(EAGA)章程和亚洲奥林匹克理事会(OCA)宪章的运动员才有参赛权。

6. 报名

报名程序将按亚洲奥林匹克理事会(OCA)宪章相关规定执行。

6.1 参赛项目人数报名

截止日期是：2013年4月30日24时(北京时间)。

6.2 参赛人员姓名报名

截止日期是：2013年8月31日24时(北京时间)。

所有运动员的参赛报名表必须在截至日期前提交，报名表所需信息须填写完整，包括运动员护照上的全名等。各奥委会成员可在报名截止前(包括当日)(例如：2013年8月31日)对最终报名表做出修改或补充，截止报名后将不准做任何的改变。

6.3 比赛队的组成

每个参赛国家/地区的奥委会可以参加男子和女子的排球比赛项目。每支比赛队由运动员12名和随队官员5名(1名领队、1名教练员、1名助理教练、1名训练员和1名医生)组成。

7. 竞赛规则

第六届东亚运动会排球比赛将按国际排联（FIVB）2009–2012年排球竞赛规则或最新排球竞赛规则执行。如新排球竞赛规则中,尚未涉及到排球竞赛规则的变化,或对竞赛规则的解释有疑议,将以英文版竞赛规则和技术手册为依据,由管委会主任或裁判主任进行统一说明和解释;出现任何规则以外的不可预见性的问题,可采用以下程序:

- 总体性事项: 依照东亚运动会联合会(EAGA)章程解决。
- 技术性事项: 依照国际排联(FIVB)最新竞赛规则之精神解决。

8. 竞赛方法

8.1 比赛分为: 预赛、半决赛和决赛

● 如果5支或者少于5支参赛队,预赛将进行单循环赛;半决赛采用第1名VS第4名(1-4)、第2名VS第3名(2-3);胜队将进行金牌的争夺(1-4胜队VS2-3胜队),负队将进行铜牌的争夺(1-4负队VS2-3负队);其他参赛队的排位将依照初赛成绩排位。

● 如果6支或者6支以上参赛队,采用抽签的形式,将参赛队分为A、B组。预赛进行A、B小组单循环赛,决定小组名次;半决赛采用交叉赛A1-B2、A2-B1;胜队将进行金牌的争夺,负者将进行铜牌的争夺;其他参赛队的按小组排名进行同名次决赛A3-B3、A4-B4、……;或进行A3-B4、A4-B3交叉赛、胜者将进行5、6名争夺,负者将进行7、8名争夺。如参赛队伍为9支,在有5支球队的小组中,获得该组预赛第五名的球队,其名次为第9名。

8.2 决定名次的办法

每场比赛按比赛结果积分，积分多者名次列前。每场比赛结果为：3:0,3:1时，胜队积3分，负队积0分；每场比赛结果为3:2时，胜队积2分，负队积1分。

如遇两队或两队以上积分相等时，队伍排名按照以下标准进行：

- 1) 取胜场次多者排名靠前；
- 2) Z值（总得分/总失分）大者名次靠前；
- 3) 若1)、2)情况下仍然相等，则C值（总胜局/总负局）大者排名靠前。

9. 抽签

第六届东亚运动会组织委员会（EAGOC）和中国排球协会（CVA）将在技术代表的监督下组织抽签仪式。抽签结束后，比赛的日期、时间和地点将公布。

10. 医务监督

10.1 兴奋剂检测

第六届东亚运动会的兴奋剂检查工作，将会根据东亚运动会医务委员会的指示以及遵照世界反兴奋剂机构（WADA）的规定程序而展开工作。

10.2 注意事项

运动员在赛后接到兴奋剂检查通知时，必须提供本人注册身份卡，并按要求去兴奋剂检查站报到，在到达兴奋剂检查站之前不得脱离陪护人员的视线，不得排尿。运动员可有一名本队人员陪同（未成年运动员必须有一名陪同）。无故拖延或拒绝兴奋剂检查将构成违反兴奋剂检查规则。

11. 器材

所有器材均依照国际排联（FIVB）章程执行。

IV. 竞赛管理



1. 管理

竞赛管理的责任由第六届东亚运动会组织委员会（EAGOC）所任命的和隶属于中国排球协会（CVA）的竞赛组织官员，在亚洲排球联合会（AVC）委派的技术代表的指导下承担。

1.1 技术组织

第六届东亚运动会排球赛事的NTO竞赛组织官员由东亚运动会组织委员会（EAGOC）和中国排球协会（CVA）协商选派，ITO竞赛组织官员由中国排球协会（CVA）和亚洲排球联合会（AVC）协商选派。

亚洲排球联合会（AVC）将在赛前成立管理委员会，成员包括：

- 管理委员会主席（由AVC委派）
- AVC技术代表
- AVC裁判员代表
- 国内技术官员（NTO）

1.2 裁判员

按照历届东亚运动会惯例，每支参赛队可报随队裁判员1名；其余不足裁判员在技术代表和中国排协（CVA）协商下产生。

1.3 申诉和投诉

所有对裁判员不公正判决提出的申诉，须有队长或主教练在赛后30分钟内向亚洲排球联合会（AVC）的管理委员会提出书面申诉。

同时，每次申诉须向亚洲排球联合会（AVC）的管理委员会缴纳300美元（或者等值的举办国货币）的申诉费。

1.4 技术会议和裁判员会议

开赛前1天，组织召开技术会议和裁判员会议，时间和地点将提前公布。

2. 运动员着装

所有参加排球比赛的参赛人员须穿着符合国际排联（FIVB）规定的服装。

3. 颁奖

3.1 颁奖仪式

颁奖仪式将在决赛后举行，获奖运动员需穿着其所属奥委会制服。

VI.天津市简介



1. 天津市概况

天津是中国四大直辖市之一。现有常住人口1355万人，辖16个区县，土地面积11916.9平方公里，海岸线153公里。

天津地处太平洋西岸渤海湾中心地带、中国华北平原的东北部，位于国际时区东八区，北纬 $38^{\circ} 34'$ — $40^{\circ} 15'$ 、东经 $116^{\circ} 43'$ — $118^{\circ} 04'$ 之间。距首都北京约120公里。

天津是中国北方地区重要的出海口。历史上便是河槽、海运重地，19世纪中叶被辟为通商口岸，逐步发展成为重要的国际商埠和金融商贸中心。海陆空交通便捷，天津港对内拥有200多万平方公里的辽阔腹地，对外与180多个国家和地区的400多个港口有贸易往来，货物吞吐量超过4.5亿吨，位居世界第4位，集装箱吞吐量达到1158万标准箱，位居世界第11位。天津滨海国际机场是中国北方最大的货物空运中心和东北亚货运集散地。

天津是中国历史文化名城。筑城建卫已有600多年历史，文化底蕴深厚。曾创造了中国近代历史上的100多项“第一”，近代史迹、文化遗存丰富多彩，有“近代百年中国看天津”之称。现有已认定的历史风貌建筑710幢，被称为“万国建筑博览会”。杨柳青年画、泥人张彩塑、魏记风筝等民间艺术闻名全国。相声、戏剧人才辈出，享有“京剧大码头”、“北方曲艺之乡”的美誉，也是中国话剧艺术的发祥地。

天津是中国首批优秀旅游城市。旅游资源丰富，山、河、湖、海、泉、湿地等旅游资源荟萃。有以自然风光和名胜古迹为特点的蓟县旅游观光区，有海湾特色的滨海旅游区，有鼓楼商贸街、五大道风情街、意式风情街、古文化街、食品街、铜锣湾等市中心旅游区。

天津是正在蓬勃发展的经济中心城市。近5年来，生产总值年均增长16%以上，全市生产总值达到11190.99亿元，人均生产总值达到1.3万美元。滨海新区开发开放的国家发展战

略加快实施，正在成为带动区域经济发展的新的增长极。生态宜居城市建设积极推进，初步形成了大气洋气、清新靓丽、中西合璧、古今交融的城市风格。按照国家明确的城市定位，天津正在努力建设成为国际港口城市、北方经济中心和生态城市。
