5. Eligibility

5.1

The NOCs of participating countries and regions are the only representatives for their athletes taking part in the 6th East Asian Games Table Tennis competition.

5.2

Only competitors who comply with East Asian Games Association (EAGA) Constitution and Constitution & Rules of the Olympic Council of Asia (OCA) are entitled to participate.

6. Entries

Entry procedures will be conducted in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Olympic Council of Asia (OCA) Constitution & Rules.

6.1 Entry by Number

Deadline: 24:00 , April 30, 2013 (Beijing local time)

6.2 Entry by Name

Deadline: 24:00 , August 31, 2013 (Beijing local time)

The completed Entry by Name Forms with all necessary information including the athlete's full name as shown in passport must be submitted for each athlete. NOCs can only make changes or submit additional information on Entry by Name Forms on or before the deadline, (i.e. 31st August 2013). No any amendments will be permitted after the deadline.

6.3 Number of Participants

- **Team Events:** Each NOC may enter a maximum of one (1) men's team and one (1) women's team. Each team shall consist of a maximum of five (5) players.

- **Individual Events:** Each NOC may enter a maximum of two (2) men and two (2) women in the singles events.

- **Doubles and Mixed Doubles Events:** Each NOC may enter two (2) pairs in each men's, women's and mixed doubles events.

7. General Rules and Regulations

The 6th East Asian Games Table Tennis competition will be conducted in accordance with the current Laws of Table Tennis and Regulations for International Competitions as published by International Table Tennis Federation (ITTF).

In case of disagreement in interpretation of the Rules, the English text shall prevail. Any unforeseen incident not covered by the Rules shall be resolved as follows:

- **General issues:** Resolved in accordance with the EAGA Constitution.

- **Technical issues:** Resolved in accordance with the spirit of latest ITTF Rules.

7.1

Team Events: The format for the Men's and Women's team events shall be:

7.1.1

The 1st Phase of Table Tennis competition will be played in groups with a round-robin system. Teams will be divided into several groups based on the total number of entries. In each team event, eight teams will be qualified through group matches for the 2nd round competition.

7.1.2

The 2nd round will be played on a knock-out system.

7.1.3

Both Men's and Women's team events will be played in the format of World Table Tennis Championships (A-X, B-Y, C-Z, A-Y, B-X). The match will be played best 3 out of 5 sets, and each set will be played best 3 out of 5 games. Each game will be played on the 11-point system.

7.1.4

No Bronze Medal match will be played. Therefore, the teams losing in the semi finals will receive Bronze Medals.

7.2 Individual Events

7.2.1

All individual events will be played on a knock-out system.

7.2.2

All Men's singles and Women's singles matches, semi finals and final matches of Mixed Doubles, Men's doubles and women's doubles will be played best 4 out of 7 games. All matches before the quarter finals for Mixed Doubles, Men's Doubles and Women's Doubles will be played best 3 out of 5 games. Each game will be played on the 11-point system.

7.2.3

No Bronze Medal match will be played. Therefore, players or pairs losing in the semi finals in any event will receive Bronze Medals.

8. Medical Control

8.1 Doping Control

Doping control for all events of the 6th East Asian Games will be conducted according to EAGA Medical Committee instructions and will follow the procedures specified by the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA).

8.2 Points for Attention

When an athlete is notified to be tested against the Doping Control after the match, he /she must go to the Doping Control Station (DCS) with a registered ID Card. The athlete may not go out of the sight of the escort or urinate before arriving at the DCS. The athlete may have a team member present throughout the entire process (a minor must have one). Those who are notified, but fail or refuse to arrive at the designated DCS may constitute an anti-doping rule violation.

9. Equipment

All attires and equipment worn or used by athletes and relative persons participating in the 6th East Asian Games Table Tennis competition shall be in conformity with regulations of the International Table Tennis Federation (ITTF). The table tennis rackets must be inspected in accordance with the ITTF Rules. One certified official officiating at the racket inspection will be appointed by Asian Table Tennis Union (ATTU).

IV. Competition Management

The responsibility for the management of the competition will be assumed by the competition officials appointed by the 6th East Asian Games Organizing Committee(EAGOC) from the Chinese Table Tennis Association(CTTA) under the guidance of the Technical Delegate appointed by ATTU.

1. Management

1.1 Referee Manager

One Referee Manager and three Assistant Referee Managers will be appointed by the Technical Delegate in consultation with Chinese Table Tennis Association (CTTA). All referee managers must be ITTF Certified International Referee Managers. At least one Referee Manager or Assistant Referee Manager shall come from associations other than CTTA.

1.2 Referees

Out of the 25 International Technical Officials (ITOs) and 16 National Technical Officials (NTOs), at least 25% of the referees with ITTF International Referees license shall come from NOCs other than the host country.

1.3 Jury of Appeal

The Jury of Appeal shall comprise 3 to 5 members appointed by the Technical Delegate in consultation with CTTA and approved by ATTU.

1.4 Protests and Appeals

In case of any dispute over the competition results, complaints and appeals shall be presented in writing to the Referee Manager on duty within 60 minutes after the match. The appeal shall only be lodged by the captain in the team events, and the players of the match in individual events.

2. Victory Ceremony

2.1 Victory Ceremony

The Victory Ceremony will be held after the finals. All award-ees must wear their NOC's official clothing.

2.2 Order of Awards

- Individual Events

First Place: Gold Medal and diploma shall be presented to the winner in each event.

Second Place: Silver Medal and diploma shall be presented to the first runner-up in each event.

Third Place: Bronze Medal and diploma shall be presented to the second runners-up in each event.

- Team Events

First Place: Gold Medal and diploma shall be presented to each member of the winning team.

Second Place: Silver Medal and diploma shall be presented to each member of the first runner-up team.

Third Place: Bronze Medal and diploma shall be presented to each member of the second runners-up team.

V . Approval of Technical Handbook

The Technical Handbook for the 6th East Asian Games Table Tennis Competition was approved by the Council of the East Asian Games Association on October 15th, 2012.

VI. Introduction to Tianjin



1. Overview

Tianjin is one of the four municipalities directly under the jurisdiction of the Chinese Central Government, with a current permanent population of 13.55 million, consisting of 16 districts and counties, and occupying a land area of 11,916.9 square kilometers, and with a coastline of 153 kilometers.

Eight hours ahead of GMT, Tianjin lies in the center of the Bohai Bay on the western coast of the Pacific Ocean, between Latitude 38°34' — 40°15' North and between Longitude 116°43' — 118°04' East. It is situated in the northeast of the North Plain in China, about 120 kilometers away from the country's capital city of Beijing.

A major access to the sea in north China, Tianjin has throughout history been an important channel of river and sea transport. As early as in the mid-19th century, it was opened as a trading port, and constant development over the years has made it an important international port and a hub of finance and commerce. The city is conveniently accessible, with well-built facilities for traffic on land, at sea and in the air. Behind, it has a vast hinterland of over two million square kilometers. Externally, it keeps trade contacts with more than 400 harbors of over 180 countries and regions, with a cargo handling capacity exceeding 450 million tons, which ranks the city at the fourth place in the world, and a standard container handling capacity of 11.58 million, standing at the 11th place in the world. Tianjin Binhai International Airport is the largest air transport hub in north China and a major freight distributing center in northeast Asia.

First built over 600 years ago, Tianjin is renowned for its splendid history and culture, boasting more than 100 “firsts” in the history of modern China. In recognition of its rich legacy of historical and cultural relics and remains, the city is reputed as “an epitome of modern China in the past hundred years”. Tianjin is also acclaimed as “an expo of western-style architectures”, with a total of 710 of its exotic buildings identified to be put under protection and preservation. Yang Liu Qing New Year Pictures, Zhang’s Painted Clay Figurines and Wei’s Kites are some of its folk arts known all over the country. A cradle of talented cross-talkers and opera performers, it is called “a center of Peking Opera” and “the land of northern Chinese folk arts”. It is also the birthplace of the modern drama in China.

Tianjin is among the first cities recognized as the country’s most outstanding tourist destinations. Natural tourism resources abound, including mountains, rivers, lakes, sea, springs, wetland, and so on. Representative natural landscapes and places of historical and cultural interests include the scenic spot in Jixian County, the sea-front, the Drum Tower commercial and business street, the Western-style buildings along Wu Da Dao, the Italian-style street, the ancient culture street, the food street, the Tong Luo Wan tourist area in the heart of the city, to name just a few.

Tianjin is an economic center undergoing booming development. As far as the past five years are concerned, the city witnessed a growth of over 16% in gross output value year-on-year to exceed 1 trillion yuan, which translated into a per capita value of 13,000 US dollars. The Binhai New Area, where the national strategic opening-up and development program is being fully implemented, is fast growing to be a new power in driving the regional economy. Construction of a more livable and eco-friendly city is proceeding fast, with its unique style taking shape, characterized by a grandeur and glamour in its integration of Chinese and Western elements, and a blend of both ancient and modern. In conformity with its positioning by the central authorities, Tianjin is well on the way to becoming an international port city, an economic center in north China and an eco-friendly community.

2. Useful Information

- Language

Putonghua (Mandarin Chinese)

- Time

Tianjin is eight hours ahead of GMT. It falls within the same time zone as Beijing, using Beijing local time.

- Voltage

The standard voltage for residential use is a single-phase AC of 220V/ 50Hz.

- Diet

Since ancient times Tianjin has been a renowned producer of fish, shrimp, crabs, clams and other aquatic and marine products. All these, especially seafood, are to the liking of its people. Among its varied traditional flavors, the Goubuli Steamed Bun with Meat Stuffing, the 18th Street Fried Dough Twists and the Er Duo Yan Er Fried Cakes are reputed as “three unique delicacies of Tianjin” enjoying tremendous popularity throughout the world. Historically an important trading port witnessing ceaseless traveling to and fro between the north and south and frequent exchanges with the outside world, varied styles of cooking –Shandong, Shanxi, Henan, Fujian, Guangdong, Zhejiang, and so on – have come to take root here in Tianjin. Court-style dishes and western delicacies are also among the favorites of the local diners.

- **Banks and Foreign Currency Exchange**

The yuan, also called renminbi (RMB), is the local unit of currency and all banks in Tianjin provide RMB services. Foreign currency can be exchanged at any branch of Bank of China. The rate of exchange of foreign currencies to RMB will depend on the quoted exchange rate given that day. Please note that foreign currency cannot be used to pay for any goods or services in China. Most business in China now accepts international credit cards including MasterCard, Visa, American Express and JCB.

VII. Weather Information

1. Climate

Located to the east coast of the Euro-Asia Continent on the middle latitude, Tianjin belongs to the monsoon region of east Asia is chiefly under the influence of the continental climate. It is characterized by distinct seasons – spring is usually windy and dry with only occasional rainfalls; summer is hot, with most of the rainfalls in the year; autumn is cool with comfortable temperatures; and winter is cold and dry without much snow.

5. 参赛资格

5.1

各个国家/地区的奥委会是参加第六届东亚运动会乒乓球赛事运动员的唯一代表。

5.2

只有符合东亚运动会联合会（EAGA）章程和亚洲奥林匹克理事会（OCA）宪章的运动员才有参赛权。

6. 报名

报名程序将按亚洲奥林匹克理事会（OCA）宪章相关规定执行。

6.1 参赛项目人数报名

截止日期是：2013年4月30日24时（北京时间）。

6.2 参赛人员姓名报名

截止日期是：2013年8月31日24时（北京时间）。

所有运动员的参赛报名表必须在截至日期前提交，报名表所需信息须填写完整，包括运动员护照上的全名等。各奥委会成员可在报名截止前（包括当日）（例如：2013年8月31日）对最终报名表做出修改或补充，截止报名后将不准做任何的变更。

6.3 参赛者人数

- 团体赛：在乒乓球比赛中每一个参赛的NOC最多可以派出男女各一支队伍，每支队伍不得超过5人。

- 个人赛：最多男女各2名选手参加男子和女子的单打比赛。

- 双打比赛和混双比赛：男双和女双各2对选手，混双2对选手。

7. 竞赛方法

第六届东亚运动会乒乓球赛事将按国际乒乓球联合会最新颁布的规则进行。出现任何规则以外的不可预见性的问题，可采用以下程序：

- 总体性事项：按东亚运动会联合会（EAGA）章程解决。

- 技术性事项：根据国际乒乓球联合会（ITTF）最新公布规则之精神解决。

7.1

团体赛：男子和女子的赛制将按照如下方式进行：

7.1.1

第一阶段的比赛将采取小组循环的形式。按照参加比赛的总数，将所有参赛队分成若干个小组。团体赛的每个项目都将有八个参赛队通过小组赛获得参加第二轮比赛的资格。

7.1.2

第二轮比赛将采取淘汰赛制。

7.1.3

男子团体和女子团体的比赛将按照乒乓球世界锦标赛的模式进行（A-X, B-Y, C-Z, A-Y, B-X），五场三胜，每场五局三胜，每局11分制。

7.1.4

不进行争夺第三名的比赛。因此，在半决赛中失利的队伍将直接获得铜牌

7.2 单项比赛

7.2.1

所有的单项比赛都以淘汰赛的方式进行。

7.2.2

男、女子单打每场七局四胜及混双、男、女子双打的半决赛、决赛每场七局四胜，每局11分制；混双、男、女子双打，四分之一决赛前的比赛采用五场三胜，每局11分制。

7.2.3

不进行争夺第三名的比赛。因此，在半决赛中失利的单打或双打选手都将直接获得铜牌。

8. 医务监督

8.1 兴奋剂检测

第六届东亚运动会的兴奋剂检查工作，将会根据东亚运动会医务委员会的指示以及遵照世界反兴奋剂机构（WADA）的规定程序而展开工作。

8.2 注意事项

运动员在赛后接到兴奋剂检查通知时，必须提供本人注册身份卡，并按要求去兴奋剂检查站报到，在到达兴奋剂检查站之前不得脱离陪护人员的视线，不得排尿。运动员可有一名本队人员陪同（未成年运动员必须有一名陪同）。无故拖延或拒绝兴奋剂检查将构成违反兴奋剂检查规则。

9. 器材

参加东亚运动会乒乓球比赛的运动员和其他人员所着服装或所用器材必须符合国际乒联（ITTF）的规定。根据国际乒联（ITTF）的规定，球拍检测是必须进行的。球拍监测将由一名由亚乒联盟(ATTU)指定的具有相关资格的官员主持。

IV. 竞赛管理



竞赛管理的责任由第六届东亚运动会组织委员会（EAGOC）所任命的和隶属于中国乒乓球协会（CTTA）的竞赛组织官员，在亚洲乒乓球联盟（ATTU）委派的技术代表的指导下承担。

1. 管理

1.1 裁判长

技术代表将同中国乒乓球协会（CTTA）共同协商指派乒乓球比赛的1名裁判长和3名副裁判长。他们必须是获得国际乒联（ITTF）资格认证的国际级裁判长。至少有一名裁判长或者副裁判长来自于中国乒乓球协会（CTTA）以外的协会。

1.2 裁判员

国际裁判员（ITO）25人，国内裁判员（NTO）16人。其中至少要有超过25%的裁判员来自主办方以外的其他奥委会成员，且具有国际乒联（ITTF）国际裁判的资格认证。

1.3 仲裁委员会

仲裁委员会由3 - 5人组成，由技术代表同中国乒协（CTTA）协商产生，并经过亚乒联（ATTU）的认可。

1.4 抗议和申诉

如果对比赛结果有异议，必须在比赛结束后60分钟之内将书面抗议提交当值的裁判长。团体赛只有队长有权提出申诉，单项比赛只有该场比赛的运动员有权提出申诉。

2. 颁奖

2.1 颁奖仪式

颁奖仪式将在决赛后举行，获奖运动员需穿着其所属奥委会制服。

VI. 天津市简介

1. 天津市概况

天津是中国北方地区重要的出海口。历史上便是河槽、海运重地，19世纪中叶被辟为通商口岸，逐步发展成为重要的国际商埠和金融商贸中心。海陆空交通便捷，天津港对内拥有200多万平方公里的辽阔腹地，对外与180多个国家和地区的400多个港口有贸易往来，货物吞吐量超过4.5亿吨，位居世界第4位，集装箱吞吐量达到1158万标准箱，位居世界第11位。天津滨海国际机场是中国北方最大的货物空运中心和东北亚货运集散地。

天津是中国历史文化名城。筑城建卫已有600多年历史，文化底蕴深厚。曾创造了中国近代历史上的100多项“第一”，近代史迹、文化遗存丰富多彩，有“近代百年中国看天津”之称。现有已认定的历史风貌建筑710幢，被称为“万国建筑博览会”。杨柳青年画、泥人张彩塑、魏记风筝等民间艺术闻名全国。相声、戏剧人才辈出，享有“京剧大码头”、“北方曲艺之乡”的美誉，也是中国话剧艺术的发祥地。

天津是中国首批优秀旅游城市。旅游资源丰富，山、河、湖、海、泉、湿地等旅游资源荟萃。有以自然风光和名胜古迹为特点的蓟县旅游观光区，有海湾特色的滨海旅游区，有鼓楼商贸街、五大道风情街、意式风情街、古文化街、食品街、铜锣湾等市中心旅游区。

天津是正在蓬勃发展的经济中心城市。近5年来，生产总值年均增长16%以上，全市生产总值达到11190.99亿元，人均生产总值达到1.3万美元。滨海新区开发开放的国家发展战

略加快实施，正在成为带动区域经济发展的新的增长极。生态宜居城市建设积极推进，初步形成了大气洋气、清新靓丽、中西合璧、古今交融的城市风格。按照国家明确的城市定位，天津正在努力建设成为国际港口城市、北方经济中心和生态城市。
