III. Competition Information

1. Dates

The 6th East Asian Games Football competition will be held from 6th to 14th, October 2013 in Tianjin.

2. Venues

2.1 Competition Venue

Tianjin Tuanbo Stadium (for men's and women's event) is located in Tianjin Health Industry Park with a seating capacity of 20,000;

Tianjin Haihe Education Park Stadium (for men's and women's event) is located in Haihe Education Garden of Tianjin with a seating capacity of 30,000;

Tianjin Olympic Center Stadium (for men's event) is located in downtown Tianjin with a seating capacity of 60,000.

2.2 Training Venue

The Training Venues include: Tianjin Normal University Football Stadium Tianjin Polytechnic University Football Stadium, Tianjin Urban Construction Institute stadium.

3. Events

The 6th East Asian Games Football competition will include Men's and Women's tournaments.

5. Eligibility

5.1

Only players born after January 1st of 1990 are entitled to participate in the competition.

5.2

The NOCs of participating countries and regions are the only representatives for their athletes taking part in the 6th East Asian Games Football competition.

5.3

Only competitors who comply with East Asian Games Association (EAGA) Constitution and Constitution & Rules of the Olympic Council of Asia (OCA) are entitled to participate. The eligibility of competitors shall be in conformity with the Fédération Internationale de Football Association (FIFA) and Asian Football Confederation (AFC) regulations.

6. Entries

Entry procedures will be conducted in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Olympic Council of Asia (OCA) Constitution & Rules.

6.1 Entry by Number

Deadline: 24:00 , April 30, 2013 (Beijing local time)

6.2 Entry by Name

Deadline: 24:00 , August 31, 2013 (Beijing local time)

The completed Entry by Name Forms with all necessary information including the athlete's full name as shown in passport must be submitted for each athlete. NOCs can only make changes or submit additional information on Entry by Names Forms on or before the deadline, (i.e. 31st August 2013). No any amendments will be permitted after the deadline.

6.3 Number of participants

Each NOC may enter 1 men's team and 1 women's team composed of twenty-three (23) players for the Football competition and seven (7) officials (1 Team Manager, 1 Head Coach, 1 Assistant Coach, 1 Goalkeeper Coach, 1 Fitness Coach, 1 Physiotherapist and 1 Team Assistant.)

7. General Rules and Regulations

7.1 Competition Rules

The 6th East Asian Games Football competition shall be conducted in accordance with the current Rules of the Fédération Internationale de Football Association (FIFA). In case of disagreement in interpretation of the Rules, the English text shall prevail. Any unforeseen incident not covered by the Rules shall be resolved as follows:

- **General issues:**

Resolved in accordance with the EAGA Constitution.

- **Technical issues:**

Resolved in accordance with the spirit of the latest FIFA regulations.

7.2 Competition Format

7.2.1 If there are 5 or fewer teams competing, the single round-robin system will be adopted after the sequences are decided through a draw.

7.2.2 If there are 6, 7, or 8 teams competing, the teams will be divided into 2 groups (A and B); the tournament will consist of heats (single round-robin system), semi finals (cross-match elimination) and final. The top 2 players of each heat will meet and play cross-match eliminations in the semi finals. The winners of the semi finals will meet in the final match, while the losers will meet in the Bronze Medal match. The grouping of teams shall be decided by a draw. The date, time and venue for the draw will be announced once confirmed.

7.2.3 If there are 9 teams competing, the teams will be divided into 3 groups (A, B and C); the tournament will consist of heats (single round-robin system), semi finals (cross-match elimination) and final. The winner of each heat and the No. 2 team with best scores will meet and play cross-match eliminations in the semi finals through a draw. The winners of the semi finals will meet in the final match, while the losers will meet in the Bronze Medal match. The grouping of teams shall be decided by a draw. The date, time and venue for the draw will be announced once confirmed.

7.3 Draw

7.3.1 The draw shall be chaired by the AFC Technical Delegate in the presence of representatives of all participating federations. The date of the draw will be announced once confirmed.

7.3.2 The AFC Technical Delegate may draw on behalf of participating federations that are unable to attend.

7.3.3 The drawing result shall be cancelled if the number of participating teams has fallen below 5. The teams will play a single round-robin competition.

7.4 Scoring and Ranking

7.4.1 The standing of each team is based on its total scores in the preliminary round. The points will be awarded as follows: 3 points for a win, 0 point for a loss, and 1 point for a tie. When 2 or more teams are tied on points, the following order of criteria shall be applied:

1. For or teams with equal scores, the one with higher scores in competitions between them shall be ranked higher.

2. For teams with equal scores, the one with more goal differences in competitions between them shall be ranked higher.

3. For teams with equal scores, the one with more goals in competitions between them shall be ranked higher.

4. For teams with equal scores, the one with more goal differences in competitions of one same phase shall be ranked higher.

5. For teams with equal scores, the one with more goals in competitions of one same phase shall be ranked higher.

6. For teams with equal scores, the one with fewer red cards in competitions of one same phase shall be ranked higher.

7. For teams with equal scores, the one with fewer yellow cards in competitions of one same phase shall be ranked higher.

8. If the tie remains, the placing shall be decided by a draw.

7.4.2 If there is no winner at the end of normal playing time of the gold medal match, i.e., 90 minutes, there shall be a play-off. If the play-off ends in a tie, penalty kicks shall be taken to decide the winner. For the cross-match elimination competitions and other matches for deciding standings, there must be a winner for each match. If there is no winner during the normal playing of 90 minutes, penalty kicks shall be taken to decide the winner.

7.5 Duration of Regular Matches and Play-off

7.5.1 Each match shall last 90 minutes, comprising two halves of 45 minutes each, with a half time interval of 15 minutes.

7.5.2 The play-off shall last 30 minutes, divided into two halves of 15 minutes each, and with no interval in between. Players may not leave the field of play without the permission of the referee.

7.6 Interval between Matches

Each team shall be granted an interval of at least 48 hours between matches.

7.7 Substitutions

No more than 3 substitutions may be used during a match, and all must be from the remaining reserve players.

7.8 Defaulted Matches and Withdrawals

When a match is defaulted, the defaulting team shall be deprived of its qualification and scores. Any red card or yellow card given to any other team in competing with the defaulting team shall become null and void. However, the supplementary penalties for those unethical athletic-related activities shall remain valid.

When a semi final match is defaulted, the next best placed team advances to the semi finals.

When the Gold Medal match is defaulted before the Bronze Medal match has started, one of its teams decided by a draw shall play in the final and the other team will be upgraded directly to the third place. When the Gold Medal match is defaulted after the Bronze Medal match has started, the Gold Medal match shall not be played. The team winning by default is declared the winner, and the third and the fourth placed teams are respectively upgraded to the second and the third places.

7.9

Starting list of each match shall be submitted to the match commissioner one hour before kick-off. The list shall include 11 starting players and 7 substitutes.

7.10

EAGOC will consult with AFC for competition format, safety and security system.

8. Medical Control

8.1 Doping Control

Doping control for all events of the 6th East Asian Games will be conducted according to EAGA Medical Committee instructions and will follow the procedures specified by the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA).

8.2 Points for Attention

When an athlete is notified to be tested against the Doping Control after the match, he /she must go to the Doping Control Station (DCS) with a registered ID Card. The athlete may not go out of the sight of the escort or urinate before arriving at the DCS. The athlete may have a team member present throughout the entire process (a minor must have 1). Those who are notified, but fail or refuse to arrive at the designated DCS may constitute an anti-doping rule violation.

9. Equipment

All equipment and installations shall comply with the Fédération Internationale de Football Association (FIFA) regulations and criteria. Only FIFA-approved footballs shall be used for the competition.

10. Pre-competition Practice

At least one free practice shall be arranged for each participating team before the formal matches.

IV. Competition Management

The responsibility for the management of the Football competition will be assumed by the competition officials appointed by EAGOC from the Chinese Football Association (CFA) under the guidance of the Technical Delegate appointed by the Asian Football Confederation Federation (AFC).

1. Management

1.1 Competition Management

AFC in cooperation with the 6th EAGOC and Chinese Football Association (CFA) will establish a Tournament Committee to manage the following:

- Competition Schedule, including the competition venues, kick-off time and dates;
- Ensuring that all matches are played in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Games;
- Giving awards and penalties in accordance with the latest FIFA regulations;
- Making decision in case of “force majeure”;

1.1.1 Director and Members of the Tournament Committee shall be appointed by AFC in consultation with EAGOC.

1.1.2 All decisions made by the Tournament Committee shall be final.

1.2 Disciplinary Committee

AFC shall establish a Disciplinary Committee, comprising 1 Chairman and other members, to be responsible for the following:

- Players or working staff dismissed from the field of play;
- Reporting any misconduct by a player or official to the Organizing Committee, and being responsible for disclosing and investigating any misconduct by a player or official;
- Dealing with other inappropriately handled matters;
- Being responsible for handling the written claims and complaints made by a member of a participating team;
- Convening a meeting timely in case of contingencies, and negotiating, making and disclosing decisions;

1.2.1 In the event that any incident as described in 1.2 occurs, it must be resolved or be responded to within 24 hours.

1.2.2 Decisions made by the Tournament Disciplinary Committee as follows shall be final.

- Cautions or Censures imposed on players, referees, assistant referees, fourth officials, delegation officials, other persons or NOC;
- Suspensions from up to 2 matches or up to 2 months imposed on players, referees, assistant referees, fourth officials, delegation officials, or other persons;
- Fines imposed on players, referees, assistant referees, fourth officials, delegation officials, or other persons shall not exceed USD 10,000, and those on national federations shall not exceed USD 20,000;

1.2.3 Any decision concerning appeals passed by the Tournament Disciplinary Committee may be lodged to the Jury of Appeals.

1.2.4 The Tournament Disciplinary Committee may only suspend a player, official, or team from taking further part in the matches of the tournament. If more severe action is required, the case must be referred to the AFC Disciplinary Committee.

1.3 Referees Committee

AFC shall appoint 1 Chairman and other members to form the Referees Committee to be responsible for the following:

- Appointing referees, assistant referees and fourth officials for all matches;
- Organizing a seminar for referees and a physical fitness test prior to the competition;
- Submitting the referees reports to the Tournament Committee within 3 hours of the conclusion of each match;

The decisions made by the Referees Committee shall be final, and may neither be appealed nor contested against.

1.4 Jury of Appeal

The Jury of Appeal shall comprise 1 representative appointed by AFC, the CFA President, and the 6th EAGOC President.

The Jury of Appeal shall hear the appeals lodged against decisions passed by the Disciplinary Committee and the Tournament Committee;

Decisions made by the Jury of Appeal shall be final, and may be neither appealed nor contested against.

1.5 Referees

The AFC may if necessary appoint in supplement to the referees accompanying the participating teams additional FIFA registered referees or other national referees in Asia nominated by its member associations. Meanwhile, the Referees Committee may, as necessary and in consultation with EAGOC, CFA and AFC invite from neutral countries referees who are on the list of international referees. A seminar for referees shall be organized prior to the start of the competition.

1.6 Official Report Forms

1.6.1 Referees and Fourth Official's Report Forms

The Referee's Report Forms together with Fourth Official's Report Forms shall be completed and transmitted with one copy respectively to FIFA and AFC immediately after the match.

1.6.2 Match Commissioner's Report Form

The Match Commissioner's Report Form together with the Match Data Sheet including the result, cases of caution, expulsions and serious incidents (if any) shall be completed and transmitted with a copy of the players' start list to the AFC immediately after the match.

1.6.3 Referee's Assessment Form

The Referee's Assessment Form shall be completed by the Member-in-charge of Referees and submitted to the AFC within 24 hours after each match.

1.6.4 Competition Report

CFA shall submit a report of the tournament to FIFA and AFC within 30 days of the completion of the Tournament. The Report may be brief, but shall be as complete as possible and contain necessary items such as events, names of competing countries/territories, names of referees and assistant referees, the difficulties encountered and the recommendations suggested for the benefit of future tournaments.

1.7 Cautions and Expulsions

1.7.1 A player who receives two cautions (yellow cards) in 2 different matches during the Tournament shall automatically be suspended for the match following the match in which he receives the second caution.

1.7.2 A player expelled from the field of play directly by a red card, or 2 cautions (yellow cards) in 1 match shall be suspended for the next match unless otherwise decided by the Disciplinary Committee.

1.8 Fair Play

1.8.1 In every match of this Competition, fair play shall be actively promoted through the fair play flags, cards, posters, etc.

1.8.2 EAGOC will present a Fair Play Trophy to the team with highest marks allocated by the Tournament Disciplinary Committee according to the FIFA guidelines.

1.9 Security

EAGOC and CFA shall be responsible for providing adequate security arrangements to all participants, officials and referees. Such security arrangements shall cover the stadium, training grounds, hotels and accommodations for players.

1.10 Others

The appointments of all match officials shall be under AFC jurisdiction. All privileges, including but not limited to access areas in the stadia, accommodation, transportation, laundry, food, allowance, must comply with AFC Regulations.

2. Uniforms

2.1

Each team shall wear its official color according to the team colors registration form sent to EAGOC.

2.2

In addition to the official outfit each team shall have a reserve outfit (reserve colors) which shall also be declared on the team colors reservation form. The colors of the reserve outfit (shirt, shorts and socks) shall be noticeably different from the colors of the official outfit (shirt, shorts and socks). The reserve outfit shall be taken to every match.

2.3

If in the opinion of the 6th East Asian Games Organizing Committee that in the Football Tournament, the colors worn by 2 opposing teams might cause confusion or prove unsuitable for television broadcasting, they shall be modified using either the entire reserve outfit or a combination of both so as to ensure a smooth match.

2.4

The goalkeepers shall wear colors contrasting with those of the 2 teams and referees.

2.5

No item of a kit worn by a field player (shirt, shorts and socks) may consist of more than 3 colors. This provision does not apply to the colors used for letters and numbers (player's name and number). If 3 colors are used, 1 shall be clearly predominant, and the other 2 shall clearly be minor colors. The predominant color shall be visible to the same extent on the back and the front of the shirt and shorts. In an exception, the fourth color may be used for the lettering or is featured permanently in the national emblem of the country/territory concerned and covers only a very small area of the shirt as a purely decorative element. The fourth color is defined as a decorative color.

2.6

Throughout the tournament, each player shall wear his registered outfit. The color of the outfit numbers must contrast clearly with the outfit (light or dark or vice versa). This applies especially in the case of striped shirts. A plain colored background (either light or dark color of the numbers) allows a better legibility. These numbers shall be between 25 cm and 35 cm in height on the back of the shirt in the center position, between 10 cm and 15 cm in height on the front of the shirt at the chest level, and between 10 cm and 15 cm in height in any position on front of either leg of the shorts. None of the numbers may contain advertising, design features or other elements.

2.7

The player's surname or nickname (or abbreviation) not exceeding 7.5 cm in height shall be affixed above the number and clearly eligible. The lettering shall be in capitals and contain no advertising, design features or other elements. The colors of the player's names shall contrast sharply with the outfits (light or dark or vice versa) and legible from a distance by spectators in the stadium as well as by television viewers. This applies especially in the case of striped shirts.

2.8

With the exception of the manufacturer's trademark, no kind of advertising for sponsors, or third parties, or slogans of political, religious or racist nature are permitted on any garments or equipment (such as shirts, shorts, goalkeeper gloves, caps, sports outfits, etc.) inside the stadium of football competition matches. The authorized trademark of the manufacturers may be used only once as a graphic logo or name, or graphic logo and name combined and shall not exceed the following area measurements:

- Shirt 20 cm²(on the chest)
- Shorts 12 cm² (on either leg)
- Socks 12 cm²
(between the ankle and the top edge)
- Thermal Shorts 12 cm²
- Goalkeeper gloves 25 cm² (a "design mark and a "word mark
"on each of the goalkeeper's gloves)
- Cap 25 cm²
- T-shirts 20 cm²
- Track-suit:
 - Jacket 20 cm²
 - Shorts/Trousers 20 cm²

2.9

Any form of advertising material on equipment (kit bags, beverage containers, plastic bottles, etc.) used within the stadium is prohibited.

2.10

Marks that are woven into or otherwise visible on the kit, including shirts, shorts, socks, goalkeepers, T-shirts or track suits, and which clearly represent the kit's manufacturer trademark either in its size or pattern, are not permitted.

2.11

The country/territory federation's emblem may also be worn as a badge on the shirt, shorts and each sock but may not exceed in area 100 cm² on the shirt, 50 cm² on shorts and 25 cm on each sock, and may not feature any advertising or other elements.

2.12

The emblem, name or abbreviation of the country/territory federation may be displayed on the shirts/shorts in the form of a badge, provided that its color must be similar to that of the shirt or shorts and it does not prevent the kit from being easily distinguished from the opposing team's kit.

2.13

The emblem of the country/territory flag shall not feature any advertising, design or other elements.

2.14

If thermal shorts are used they shall be the same color as the main color of the shorts.

2.15

The finalist teams shall present AFC with a sample of the official and reserve outfits (shirts, shorts, socks, and goalkeeper's kit, gloves and caps) that they intend to use during the final competition for approval within the time-limit set by the Tournament Committee.

3. Victory Ceremony

3.1 Victory Ceremony

The Victory Ceremony will be held after the finals. All award-ees must wear their NOC's official clothing.

3.2 Order of Awards

First Place: Gold Medal and diploma shall be presented to each member of the winning team

Second Place: Silver Medal and diploma shall be presented to each member of the first runner-up team

Third Place: Bronze Medal and diploma shall be presented to each member of the second runner-up team

V . Approval of Technical Handbook

The Technical Handbook for the 6th East Asian Games Football Competition was approved by the Council of the East Asian Games Association on October 15th, 2012.

VI. Introduction to Tianjin



1. Overview

Tianjin is one of the four municipalities directly under the jurisdiction of the Chinese Central Government, with a current permanent population of 13.55 million, consisting of 16 districts and counties, and occupying a land area of 11,916.9 square kilometers, and with a coastline of 153 kilometers.

Eight hours ahead of GMT, Tianjin lies in the center of the Bohai Bay on the western coast of the Pacific Ocean, between Latitude 38°34' —40°15' North and between Longitude 116°43' —118°04' East. It is situated in the northeast of the North Plain in China, about 120 kilometers away from the country's capital city of Beijing.

A major access to the sea in north China, Tianjin has throughout history been an important channel of river and sea transport. As early as in the mid-19th century, it was opened as a trading port, and constant development over the years has made it an important international port and a hub of finance and commerce. The city is conveniently accessible, with well-built facilities for traffic on land, at sea and in the air. Behind, it has a vast hinterland of over two million square kilometers. Externally, it keeps trade contacts with more than 400 harbors of over 180 countries and regions, with a cargo handling capacity exceeding 450 million tons, which ranks the city at the fourth place in the world, and a standard container handling capacity of 11.58 million, standing at the 11th place in the world. Tianjin Binhai International Airport is the largest air transport hub in north China and a major freight distributing center in northeast Asia.

First built over 600 years ago, Tianjin is renowned for its splendid history and culture, boasting more than 100 “firsts” in the history of modern China. In recognition of its rich legacy of historical and cultural relics and remains, the city is reputed as “an epitome of modern China in the past hundred years”. Tianjin is also acclaimed as “an expo of western-style architectures”, with a total of 710 of its exotic buildings identified to be put under protection and preservation. Yang Liu Qing New Year Pictures, Zhang’s Painted Clay Figurines and Wei’s Kites are some of its folk arts known all over the country. A cradle of talented cross-talkers and opera performers, it is called “a center of Peking Opera” and “the land of northern Chinese folk arts”. It is also the birthplace of the modern drama in China.

Tianjin is among the first cities recognized as the country’s most outstanding tourist destinations. Natural tourism resources abound, including mountains, rivers, lakes, sea, springs, wetland, and so on. Representative natural landscapes and places of historical and cultural interests include the scenic spot in Jixian County, the sea-front, the Drum Tower commercial and business street, the Western-style buildings along Wu Da Dao, the Italian-style street, the ancient culture street, the food street, the Tong Luo Wan tourist area in the heart of the city, to name just a few.

Tianjin is an economic center undergoing booming development. As far as the past five years are concerned, the city witnessed a growth of over 16% in gross output value year-on-year to exceed 1 trillion yuan, which translated into a per capita value of 13,000 US dollars. The Binhai New Area, where the national strategic opening-up and development program is being fully implemented, is fast growing to be a new power in driving the regional economy. Construction of a more livable and eco-friendly city is proceeding fast, with its unique style taking shape, characterized by a grandeur and glamour in its integration of Chinese and Western elements, and a blend of both ancient and modern. In conformity with its positioning by the central authorities, Tianjin is well on the way to becoming an international port city, an economic center in north China and an eco-friendly community.

Tianjin is eight hours ahead of GMT. It falls within the same time zone as Beijing, using Beijing local time.

- **Voltage**

The standard voltage for residential use is a single-phase AC of 220V/ 50Hz.

Since ancient times Tianjin has been a renowned producer of fish, shrimp, crabs, clams and other aquatic and marine products. All these, especially seafood, are to the liking of its people. Among its varied traditional flavors, the Goubuli Steamed Bun with Meat Stuffing, the 18th Street Fried Dough Twists and the Er Duo Yan Er Fried Cakes are reputed as “three unique delicacies of Tianjin” enjoying tremendous popularity throughout the world. Historically an important trading port witnessing ceaseless traveling to and fro between the north and south and frequent exchanges with the outside world, varied styles of cooking –Shandong, Shanxi, Henan, Fujian, Guangdong, Zhejiang, and so on – have come to take root here in Tianjin. Court-style dishes and western delicacies are also among the favorites of the local diners.

- **Banks and Foreign Currency Exchange**

The yuan, also called renminbi (RMB), is the local unit of currency and all banks in Tianjin provide RMB services. Foreign currency can be exchanged at any branch of Bank of China. The rate of exchange of foreign currencies to RMB will depend on the quoted exchange rate given that day. Please note that foreign currency cannot be used to pay for any goods or services in China. Most business in China now accepts international credit cards including MasterCard, Visa, American Express and JCB.

VII. Weather Information

1. Climate

Located to the east coast of the Euro-Asia Continent on the middle latitude, Tianjin belongs to the monsoon region of east Asia is chiefly under the influence of the continental climate. It is characterized by distinct seasons – spring is usually windy and dry with only occasional rainfalls; summer is hot, with most of the rainfalls in the year; autumn is cool with comfortable temperatures; and winter is cold and dry without much snow.

参赛运动员应于1990年1月1日后出生。

5.2

各个国家/地区的奥委会是参加第六届东亚运动会足球赛事运动员的唯一代表。

5.3

只有完全遵守东亚运动会联合会（EAGA）章程和亚奥理事会（OCA）宪章的运动员才有资格参加比赛，比赛选手的资格应遵守国际足球联合会（FIFA）和亚洲足球联合会（AFC）的规则。

6. 报名

报名程序将按亚洲奥林匹克理事会（OCA）宪章相关规定执行。

6.1 参赛项目人数报名

截止日期是：2013年4月30日24时（北京时间）。

6.2 参赛人员姓名报名

截止日期是：2013年8月31日24时（北京时间）。

所有运动员的参赛报名表必须在截至日期前提交，报名表所需信息须填写完整，包括运动员护照上的全名等。各奥委会成员可在报名截止前（包括当日）（例如：2013年8月31日）对最终报名表做出修改或补充，截止报名后将不准做任何的变更。

6.3 参赛者人数

每个国家/地区奥委会可以派出男子、女子各一支由23名球员和7名随队官员（1名经理、1名主教练、1名助理教练、1名守门员教练、1名健身教练、1名医药护理人员和1名随队助理）组成的队伍参加足球比赛。

7. 竞赛方法

7.1 竞赛规则

第六届东亚运动会足球比赛将服从国际足球联合会（FIFA）最新发布的规则，如对规则解释有争议，将以英文版本为准。出现任何规则以外的不可预见性的问题，可采用以下程序：

- 总体性事项：

按东亚运动会联合会（EAGA）章程解决。

- 技术性事项：

根据国际足联（FIFA）最新公布规则之精神解决。

7.2 竞赛编排

7.2.1 如果只有5支或者少于5支队伍参赛，则通过抽签落位后进行单循环比赛。

7.2.2 如果有6、7或者8支队伍参赛，所有的参赛队伍通过抽签分为2个小组（A组和B组）进行比赛。比赛分为小组赛（单循环）、半决赛（交叉淘汰赛）和决赛。小组赛的前二名进入半决赛，进行交叉淘汰赛，获胜的两支队伍进行最终的决赛，负队将进行第三、四名的比赛。分组将由抽签决定，抽签的时间、日期和地点另行通知。

7.2.3 如果有9支队伍参赛，所有的参赛队伍通过抽签分为3个小组（A组、B组和C组）进行比赛，比赛分为小组赛（单循环）、半决赛（交叉淘汰赛）和决赛，每个小组的第一名和最好成绩的第二名通过抽签进行半决赛阶段的交叉比赛，获胜的两支队伍进行最终的决赛，负队将进行第三、四名的比赛。分组将由抽签决定，抽签的时间、日期和地点另行通知。

7.3 抽签

7.3.1 抽签仪式由亚洲足球联合会（AFC）的技术代表主持，所有参赛协会代表参加，具体日期另行通知。

7.3.2 如参赛协会的代表无法到场，可由亚洲足球联合会（AFC）技术代表代为抽签。

7.3.3 如果抽签之后参赛队伍的数量减至5支以下，则抽签结果取消，直接进行单循环赛。

7.4 计分和决定名次办法

7.4.1 依照球队在小组赛中获得的积分进行成绩排位，胜一场获3分；负一场获0分；平一场获1分。如遇两队或两队以上积分相等，依次根据以下条件排列名次：

1. 积分相等队之间相互比赛积分多者，名次列前；
2. 积分相等队之间相互比赛净胜球多者，名次列前；
3. 积分相等队之间相互比赛进球数多者，名次列前；
4. 积分相等队在同一阶段比赛中净胜球数多者，名次列前；
5. 积分相等队在同一阶段比赛中进球总数多者，名次列前；
6. 积分相等队在同一阶段比赛中获得红牌总数少者，名次列前；
7. 积分相等队在同一阶段比赛中获得黄牌总数少者，名次列前；
8. 如仍相等，以抽签形式决定名次。

7.4.2 只有在冠亚军决赛中，如在90分钟内平局，则进行加时赛。如加时赛仍平局，则以踢球点球办法决出胜负。交叉淘汰赛和决定其他名次的比赛，每场比赛必须决出胜负，如90分钟比赛为平局，则直接以踢球点球办法决出胜负。

7.5 正常比赛时间和加时赛

7.5.1 全场比赛为90分钟（上、下半时各45分钟），中场休息不得超过15分钟。

7.5.2 加时赛为30分钟（上、下半时各15分钟），中场不休息。未经裁判允许，运动员不得离场。

7.6 赛间休息

每支参赛队伍两场比赛之间休息至少48小时。

7.7 换人

每场比赛换人数不得超过3人，必须从替补球员中选择替换上场的球员。

7.8 弃赛和退赛

如果有参赛队伍缺席比赛，则取消该运动队的参赛资格，取消该队的比赛成绩，所有球队已经与之比赛的成绩和发生的红、黄牌取消，但对非体育道德行为做出的追加处罚依然有效。

如在半决赛阶段比赛开始前有队伍缺席比赛，可按上一阶段成绩依次替补参赛队。

如在决赛中有队伍缺席比赛，且在争夺铜牌的比赛尚未开始的情况下，则进行铜牌争夺战的两支队伍抽签，获胜的一支队伍直接进入决赛，另一支队伍直接获得铜牌；如果决赛中其中一支队伍缺席比赛，而且铜牌比赛已经进行，则无须在进行决赛，直接获得冠军。获得3-4名的队伍自动递补名次至2-3名。

7.9

首发名单须在开赛前一个小时提交给比赛监督，名单包括11名首发和7名替补球员。

7.10

东亚运动会组委会（EAGOC）将会与亚洲足球联合会（AFC）协商比赛形式、安全和安保系统问题。

8. 医务监督

8.1 兴奋剂检测

第六届东亚运动会的兴奋剂检查工作，将会根据东亚运动会医务委员会的指示以及遵照世界反兴奋剂机构（WADA）的规范程序而展开工作。

8.2 注意事项

运动员在赛后接到兴奋剂检查通知时，必须提供本人注册身份卡，并按要求去兴奋剂检查站报到，在到达兴奋剂检查站之前不得脱离陪护人员的视线，不得排尿。运动员可有一名本队人员陪同（未成年运动员必须有一名陪同）。无故拖延或拒绝兴奋剂检查将构成违反兴奋剂检查规则。

9. 器材

所有的器械和设施都要遵守国际足球联合会（FIFA）的规定和规格。比赛用球均采用国际足球联合会（FIFA）认可的足球。

10. 赛前训练

赛前，应为每个参赛队在比赛场馆至少安排一次适应性训练。

IV. 竞赛管理

竞赛管理的责任由第六届东亚运动会组织委员会(EAGOC)所任命的和隶属于中国足球协会(CFA)的竞赛组织官员,在亚洲足球联合会(AFC)委派的技术代表的指导下承担。

1. 管理

1.1 比赛管理

亚洲足球联合会(AFC)与第六届东亚运动会组织委员会(EAGOC)和中国足球协会(CFA)合作,设立竞赛委员会来负责以下事项:

- 比赛日程:包括比赛场地、开赛时间及日期安排。
- 保证各场比赛按足球比赛规则和规定进行比赛。
- 进行奖励和处罚,按照国际足球联合会(FIFA)的最新规定进行奖励和处罚。
- 对不可抗性情况下的决定。

1.1.1 由亚洲足球联合会(AFC)和东亚运动会组织委员会(EAGOC)协商指定竞赛委员会的主任和成员。

1.1.2 所有竞赛委员会做出的决定为最终决定。

1.2 纪律委员会

亚洲足球联合会(AFC)应组成一个纪律委员会,其中应有1名主席及委员组成。具体处理以下等事件:

- 球员或工作人员被逐出场。
- 将球员或者官员做出任何处理不当的事情报告给组委会,负责揭发和调查球员或者官员处理不当的事务。
- 对于其他处理不当的事情进行处理。
- 负责参赛队伍工作人员的书面要求及投诉。
- 遇到突发性事件应及时召开会议,商讨处理结果并公布于众。

1.2.1 所有1.2中发生的事项都要在24小时之内解决或者给出回复。

1.2.2 由纪律委员会通过下列决定为最终议案：

- 给予球员，裁判员，助理裁判员，第四官员，代表团官员，其他人员或NOC以警告或责备；

- 给予球员，裁判员，助理裁判员，第四官员，代表团官员或者其他人员进行停赛2场或者2个月的停赛处罚；

- 对球员，裁判员，助理裁判员，第四官员，代表团官员或者其他人员的罚款不得超过10000元美金，对国家（地区）联合会的罚款不得超过20000元美金。

1.2.3 纪律委员会可向仲裁委员会提交有关上诉所做出的任何决定；

1.2.4 纪律委员会只能在赛事期间对球员、工作人员及队伍做出停赛处分。如有需要进一步处理，有关事件必须提交到亚洲足球联合会（AFC）纪律委员会处理。

1.3 裁判委员会

由亚洲足球联合会（AFC）指派一名主席及委员组成裁判委员会，处理以下事项：

- 指派所有赛事的裁判员、助理裁判员及第四官员。

- 在赛事举行前组织裁判员研讨会及体能测试。

- 于赛事结束后3小时内向竞赛委员会提交裁判员报告。

裁判委员会做出的所有决定为最后决议，任何上诉或异议均不为接受。

1.4 仲裁委员会

仲裁委员会由亚洲足球联合会（AFC）指派一名代表、中国足球协会（CFA）主席和第六届东亚运动会组委会主席组成。

- 仲裁委员会应听取纪律委员会和竞赛委员会的上诉决定。

- 仲裁委员会做出的所有决定将为最后决议，不再做出上诉及辩论。

1.5 裁判员

除参赛队伍随队裁判员外，如有需要，亚洲足球联合会（AFC）可指派在国际足球联合会（FIFA）注册的裁判员或者在会员协会提供的其他亚洲裁判员名单中挑选本届运动会的裁判员，作为补充人选。同时，根据需要，裁判委员会与第六届东亚运动会组委会、中国足球协会（CFA）及亚洲足球联合会（AFC）协商后，邀请在国际裁判员名单之中的中立国家的裁判员。并于赛事前组织一个裁判员研讨会。

1.6 工作人员报告表格

1.6.1 裁判员及第四裁判员表格:

裁判员报告表格及第四裁判员报告表格,应于比赛结束后完成,并向国际足球协会(FIFA)及亚洲足球联合会(AFC)各提交副本一份。

1.6.2 赛事监督表格

赛事监督表格及赛事资料表,包括赛事成绩、警告个案、被逐离场及严重意外等等,应于赛事结束后完成,并附上出场队员名单副本,立刻向亚洲足球联合会(AFC)提交。

1.6.3 裁判员评核表

裁判监督应于各场比赛完成结束后24小时内,向亚洲足球联合会(AFC)提交裁判员评核表。

1.6.4 赛事报告

中国足球协会(CFA)应于赛事结束后30天内,向国际足球联合会(FIFA)及亚洲足球联合会(AFC)提交赛事报告。赛事报告可简洁概要,但如有可能应尽量完善内容,包括项目、参赛国家/地区名称、裁判员、助理裁判员的姓名,遇到问题可以给出建议,以利日后完善其他赛事。

1.7 警告及被逐离场

1.7.1 一名球员如在赛事期间累积了两次警告(黄牌),将于接受第二次警告后的一场比赛自动被判罚停赛。

1.7.2 当一名运动员被裁判员出示红牌或者一场比赛中连续两次黄牌警告,将直接被驱逐出场,并且停赛一场(被警告那场比赛的下一场比赛),除非纪律委员会对判罚做出其他的决定。

1.8 公平竞技

1.8.1 赛事期间的任何比赛都应针对公平竞争进行宣传,比如通过公平竞技旗帜、宣传画、海报等积极的宣传。

1.8.2 第六届东亚运动会组委会(EAGOC)将设立公平竞技奖,将由纪律委员会根据按照国际足球联合会(FIFA)的指示方针给各队评出分数,分数最高者将获此殊荣。

1.9 安保

东亚运动会组委会(EAGOC)和中国足球协会(CFA)将为所有的运动员、工作人员和裁判员提供足够的安保服务,安保工作包括运动场和训练场馆、酒店和运动员住宿处等。

1.10 其他事项

亚洲足球联合会（AFC）的权限大于所有被任命的比赛官员的权限。所有的特权，包括除了被限制进入场馆内的区域以外，比如：住宿、交通、洗衣房、食物供应等特权都将服从于亚洲足球联合会（AFC）的规定。

2. 服装

2.1

各队须穿官方颜色的制服，并应与提交第六届东亚运动会组委会（EAGOC）的队伍颜色注册表上的颜色相符；

2.2

除正式服装外，各队应有一套备用服装（后备颜色），并应于队伍颜色注册表上声明后备服装的颜色（球衣、短裤和长袜），且与正式服装的颜色（球衣、短裤和长袜）有所不同，每场比赛需携带备用服装；

2.3

第六届东亚运动会组委会（EAGOC）对该届运动会的足球项目要求：如认为比赛的队伍服装颜色不容易区分或者不适合电视转播，队伍应使用全套备用服装或者混合使用，以利于比赛顺利进行。

2.4

守门员的球衣颜色必须与其他球员的衣服及裁判员的服装颜色有明显的区别。

2.5

运动员的整套服装（球衣、短裤和球袜）的颜色不可超过3种颜色组成，不包括文字和数字（球员的名称和球衣号码）。3种颜色使用时，有一种颜色必须清楚显示为主色，其余的显示次色。球衣和短裤主颜色范围必需是前面和后面的一样可见。在例外的情况下可以使用第4种颜色，该颜色只能与一种字型相同或者永久作为地区徽章的一部分，而且只能是在球衣上的一个小装饰。第4种颜色被视为一种装饰的颜色。

2.6

在比赛期间，各运动员必需穿着已注册的球衣，号码的颜色必须与比赛服装的颜色有显著的分别（浅色或深色或相反的颜色），穿着条纹球衣的队伍尤应遵守此规则。单色背景（浅色或深色的号码）的球衣比较清楚，球衣号码必需在球衣背面的中央位置高度为25厘米至35厘米之间，正面在胸部位置高度为10厘米到15厘米之间，短裤任一腿正面高度为10厘米至15厘米之间。所有号码不能包括广告、设计特色或其它元素。

2.7

球员的姓氏或者绰号（或缩写）高度不能超过7.5厘米且必需清楚贴在球衣号码之上，字型必需是大写字母且不能包含广告、设计特色或其它元素。球员姓名的颜色必需与比赛服装有显著区别（浅色或深色或相反的颜色），且在远距离可以让观众在场馆里和电视里清楚辨认，特别是有条纹的队服上一定要注意这项规则。

2.8

在足球比赛的场馆中，除了生产商注册的商标外，不容许有广告赞助商或第三者商标、政治标语、宗教标语、种族歧视和其他标语在任何衣服（球衣、短裤、守门员手套、帽子和运动服等。）和器材上。生产商注册的商标或名字或商标与名字组合，只能用于服装的一处，并不能超过以下的尺寸：

- 球衣 —— 20平方厘米(在胸部)
- 短裤 —— 12平方厘米(任一腿)
- 球袜 —— 12平方厘米(在足踝与顶口之间)
- 铲球裤 —— 12平方厘米
- 守门员手套 —— 25平方厘米（“设计记号”和“字形记号”在每边手套上）
- 帽子 —— 25平方厘米
- 汗衫 —— 20平方厘米
- 运动套装：
 - 外套 —— 20平方厘米
 - 短裤/长裤 —— 20平方厘米

2.9

场馆内禁止带有广告之物品(运动袋、饮品容器、塑料杯等等)

2.10

运动员的队服,包括:如球衣、短裤、球袜、守门员手套、帽子、汗衫或运动套装上不可织上或用其他方法系上明显代表运动装备生产商的标志,无论是该标志的尺寸还是图案形状。

2.11

国家/地区协会的标志只允许有一个徽章在球衣、短裤和每一边球袜上,但在球衣上不能超过100平方厘米,在短裤上不能超过50平方厘米,在每一边球袜不能超过25厘米,也不能带有任何广告特徵及其他元素。

2.12

国家/地区协会的标志、名称或缩写可以以徽章的形式显示在球衣上,而此徽章的颜色必需与球衣或短裤相似,且不妨碍辨识比赛队伍。

2.13

国家/地区旗帜的徽章不能有任何广告特色、设计或其他元素

2.14

若穿着铲球裤,那其颜色必需与球衣主颜色一样。

2.15

决赛的参赛队伍,必需在竞赛委员会所定的期限内向亚洲足球联合会(AFC)递交和申请决赛期间的正式和后备服装,包括:球衣、短裤、球袜、守门员服装、手套、帽子的样本。

3.1 颁奖仪式

颁奖仪式将在决赛后举行,获奖运动员需穿着其所属奥委会制服。

3.2 奖项颁发如下

冠军:授予队伍各成员金牌和证书

亚军:授予队伍各成员银牌和证书

季军:授予队伍各成员铜牌和证书

VI. 天津市简介

1. 天津市概况

天津是中国四大直辖市之一。现有常住人口1355万人，辖16个区县，土地面积11916.9平方公里，海岸线153公里。

天津地处太平洋西岸渤海湾中心地带、中国华北平原的东北部，位于国际时区东八区，北纬 $38^{\circ} 34'$ — $40^{\circ} 15'$ 、东经 $116^{\circ} 43'$ — $118^{\circ} 04'$ 之间。距首都北京约120公里。

天津是中国北方地区重要的出海口。历史上便是河槽、海运重地，19世纪中叶被辟为通商口岸，逐步发展成为重要的国际商埠和金融商贸中心。海陆空交通便捷，天津港对内拥有200多万平方公里的辽阔腹地，对外与180多个国家和地区的400多个港口有贸易往来，货物吞吐量超过4.5亿吨，位居世界第4位，集装箱吞吐量达到1158万标准箱，位居世界第11位。天津滨海国际机场是中国北方最大的货物空运中心和东北亚货运集散地。

天津是中国历史文化名城。筑城建卫已有600多年历史，文化底蕴深厚。曾创造了中国近代历史上的100多项“第一”，近代史迹、文化遗存丰富多彩，有“近代百年中国看天津”之称。现有已认定的历史风貌建筑710幢，被称为“万国建筑博览会”。杨柳青年画、泥人张彩塑、魏记风筝等民间艺术闻名全国。相声、戏剧人才辈出，享有“京剧大码头”、“北方曲艺之乡”的美誉，也是中国话剧艺术的发祥地。

天津是中国首批优秀旅游城市。旅游资源丰富，山、河、湖、海、泉、湿地等旅游资源荟萃。有以自然风光和名胜古迹为特点的蓟县旅游观光区，有海湾特色的滨海旅游区，有鼓楼商贸街、五大道风情街、意式风情街、古文化街、食品街、铜锣湾等市中心旅游区。

天津是正在蓬勃发展的经济中心城市。近5年来，生产总值年均增长16%以上，全市生产总值达到11190.99亿元，人均生产总值达到1.3万美元。滨海新区开发开放的国家发展战略

加快实施，正在成为带动区域经济发展的新的增长极。生态宜居城市建设积极推进，初步形成了大气洋气、清新靓丽、中西合璧、古今交融的城市风格。按照国家明确的城市定位，天津正在努力建设成为国际港口城市、北方经济中心和生态城市。
